## Payment Options

### Sliding Fee Scale

A sliding fee scale discount for services is based on income and number of family members. This discount is confidential and persons applying for the discount must provide documentation of income.

### Insurance

We accept most **private insurances** as well as **Medicaid, Medicare** and the **Children’s Health Insurance Program (CHIP)**. We provide “**Affordable Quality Care**”. Based upon a patient’s ability to pay.
